

Name of memorial: Elphin I.R.A. Memorial

Place: Shankill crossroads, Elphin.

Address and map reference: Shankill crossroads, Elphin, Co. Roscommon. On R369, 150 metres from junction with N 61, and 2km west of Elphin.
Map reference: 857 877 (Sheet 33).
Co-ordinates: N 53.8391°; W 8.2182°.

Access: at all times. Parking: adjacent. Disabled access: only to outside of enclosure (three steps).

Position: in a walled and railed enclosure at the roadside.

Description and dimensions: Statues of three IRA men sculpted in concrete on a rough stone triangular base. Irish versions of names are on a stone book on a plinth to the front. A plaque on construction is to right side of plinth. A stone with English versions of names is at left boundary wall. A stone with a portrait relief, commemorating the 100th anniversary of Pearse's birth is on the right boundary wall.

Height: appx. 500cms. Width: appx. 400cms. Depth appx. 400cms.
