To the Glory of God and in loving memory of

**S. H. Lewis Lt 2nd Bt. The Connaught Rangers who laid down his
life in Gallipoli on Aug. 28th 1915. Greater love hath no man than this
that a man lay down his life for his friends.**

Brass plaque:

**This memorial window
is to Lieutenant Stephen Henry
Lewis, who died serving with
the 5th Battalion of the
Connaught Rangers in the
battle for Hill 60 in Gallipoli,
Turkey, August 1915.
In the picture he is very
imaginatively depicted as a
medieval knight receiving
his heavenly reward – but his face
is real, almost like a photograph.
