

**Name of memorial:** Cedar Room

**Place:** Arbour Hill Church

**Address and map reference:** The Church of the Sacred Heart, Church of the Defence Forces, Arbour Hill, Dublin 7. Map reference: O 141 346 (Sheet 50).

**Position:** At base of north-east tower, accessible from the nave.

**Description and dimensions:** A bare room commemorating U.N service in South Lebanon. It contains a painting of "Dawn Foot Patrol leaving an Irish Post" by Michael Clarke, the trunk of a yew tree bearing a book with the names of the 47 Irish men who died in the 23 years of peace-keeping in South Lebanon, a tall candle, also bearing the names, a cross made of shrapnel and the Lebanon Box containing soil from Tibnine, South Lebanon.
